I wish them all the best for their prosperous life ahead.

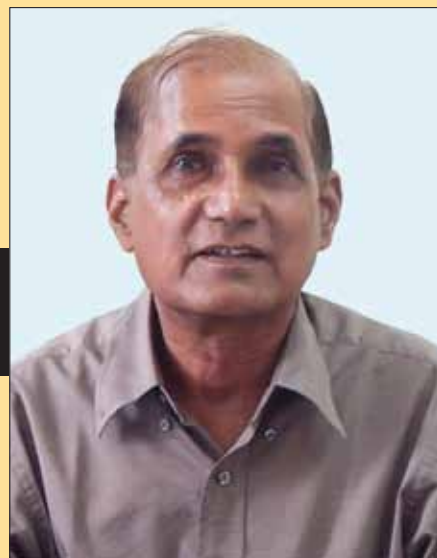

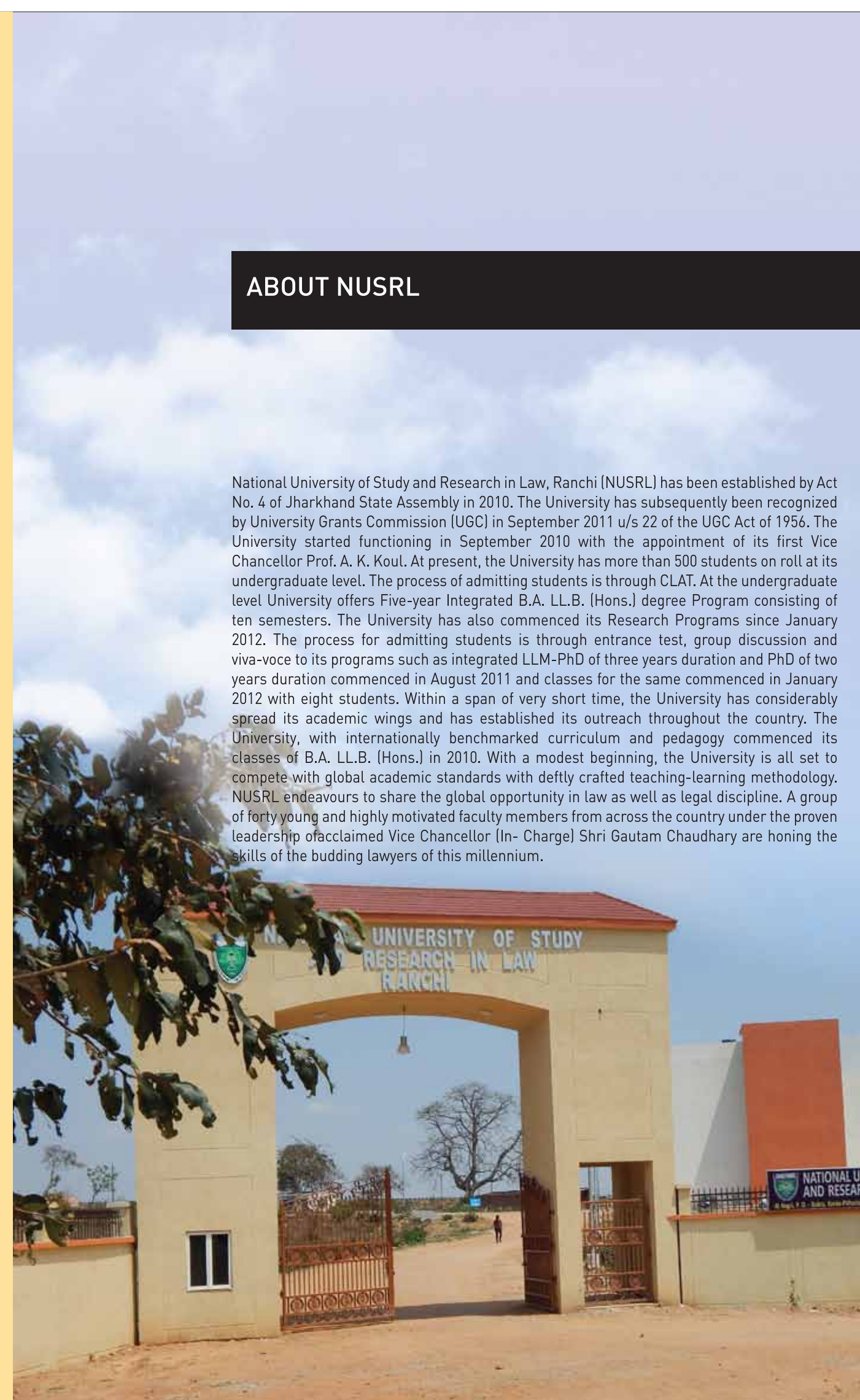

## ABOUT NUSRL

National University of Study and Research in Law, Ranchi (NUSRL) has been established by Act No. 4 of Jharkhand State Assembly in 2010. The University has subsequently been recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC) in September 2011 u/s 22 of the UGC Act of 1956. The University started functioning in September 2010 with the appointment of its first Vice Chancellor Prof. A. K. Koul. At present, the University has more than 500 students on roll at its undergraduate level. The process of admitting students is through CLAT. At the undergraduate level University offers Five-year Integrated B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) degree Program consisting of ten semesters. The University has also commenced its Research Programs since January 2012. The process for admitting students is through entrance test, group discussion and viva-voce to its programs such as integrated LLM-PhD of three years duration and PhD of two years duration commenced in August 2011 and classes for the same commenced in January 2012 with eight students. Within a span of very short time, the University has considerably spread its academic wings and has established its outreach throughout the country. The University, with internationally benchmarked curriculum and pedagogy commenced its classes of B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) in 2010. With a modest beginning, the University is all set to compete with global academic standards with deftly crafted teaching-learning methodology. 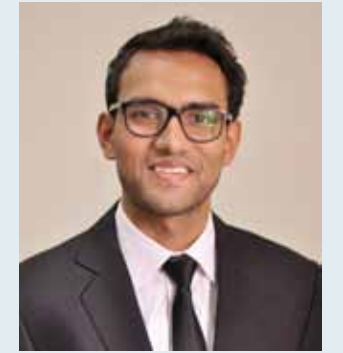

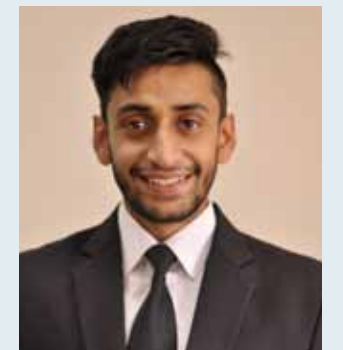

## EVALUATION PATTERN

The evaluation system at NUSRL, Ranchi comprises of examinations, project reports, viva-voce, seminar presentations and court room exercises. At the end of every semester, each student is marked out of a total of 100 for every subject.

Out of the total 100 marks, 30 marks is for Continuous Assessment Test (CAT) which is carried out during the semesters, 20 marks is for mid semester examinations and the rest 50 forms part of the end semester examinations. For the law subjects, 15 out of the 30 marks reserved for CAT, forms part of court room exercises (CRE).

Attendance- A student is required to be regular in classes and expected to have 100% attendance and condonation up to 30% can be considered for specific cogent reasons for making him eligible to appear in the End Term Examination of the concerned semester. No relaxation beyond 30% is considered in any case.

Grading System - The grading system of the University follows a pointer system which is operative in the following manner:

- Each course carries a weightage of 6 credit points. Honors paper carries a weightage of 10 credit points.
- Grade Point Average (GPA) weighs the average performance in the semester, whereas Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) weighs the same across the academic session attended.
- At NUSRL, the students are evaluated on a ten point Cumulative Grade Point System (CGPA).
- A student will be deemed to have completed the requirements for graduation if he/she has
  - a. Passed all prescribed courses.
  - b. CGPA >5.5
  - c. Cleared all dues of the University, hostel, library etc.
  - d. Has no case of indiscipline pending against him.

*A student with a CGPA below 5.5 OR having any pending E grades will not be allowed to graduate*

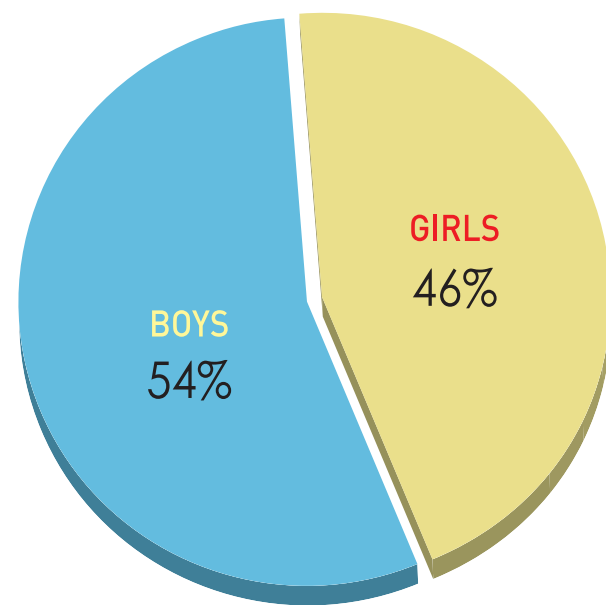

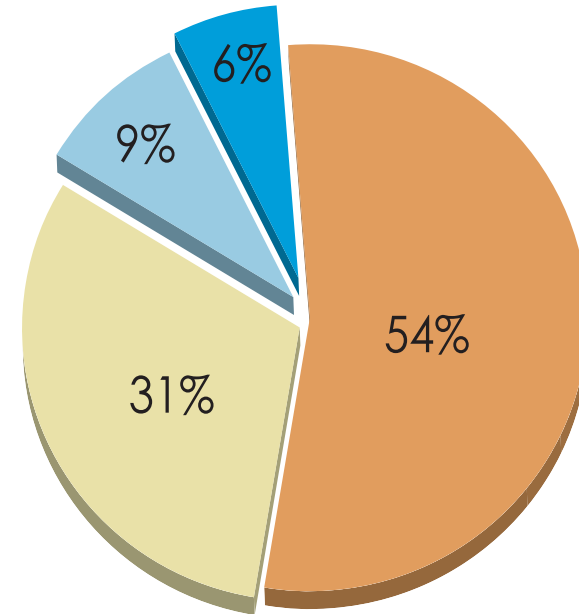

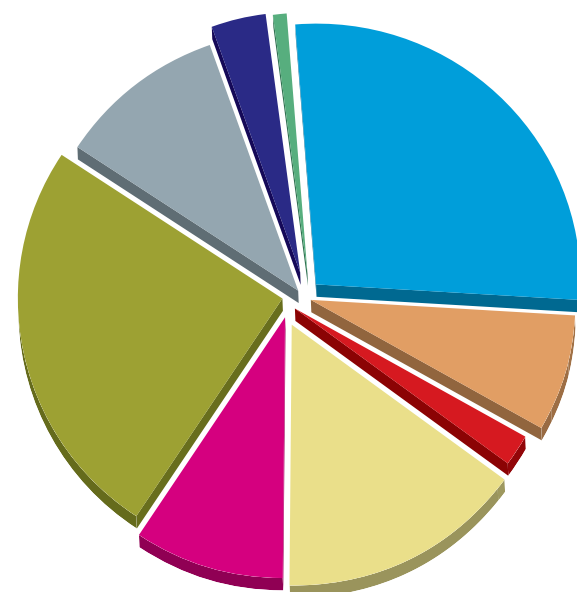

## NUSRL INITIATIVES

### Centre for Study and Research in Intellectual Property Rights (CSRIPR)

The Centre has been founded with the aim of gaining thoughtful knowledge in the field of patent, trademark, design and copyright law along with other growing issues on IPR. CSRIPR strives to organize a lot of activities on an interdisciplinary level in order to gain better insight & glimpse into the evolving arena of Intellectual Property Law. These activities include fundamental research, gathering of documents, organizing conferences and providing scientific service to the community.

### Centre for Study and Research in Child Rights (CSRCR)

This Centre is an initiative to conduct research work in the field of child rights, especially the problems that abound the state of Jharkhand. Ranchi is the capital of the Indian state of Jharkhand, and now it is the most populous city of the state. The name Ranchi is derived from the previous name of the Oraon village at the same site, Archi. "Archi" derives from the Oraon word for bamboo grove or stave. Although Ranchi has a humid subtropical climate, its location and the forests surrounding it combine to produce the unusually pleasant climate for which it is known. Ranchi has many reputed educational institutions, a few prominent ones being Central University of Jharkhand (CUJ), Ranchi University (RU), Birla Institute of Technology (BIT), Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Ranchi, Institute of Management Studies (IMS) Ranchi, National Institute of Foundry and Forge Technology (NIFFT), Rajendra Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS), Xavier Institute of Social Service (XISS), Birsa Agricultural University, Sai Nath University, Amity University, Ranchi.

Ranchi has numerous industries running in and around the city, the major ones being Usha Martin, MECON, CCL, CMPDI and HEC. The 34th National Games were successfully held in Ranchi in February 2011. An International Cricket stadium with an indoor stadium and a practice ground has been constructed. Apart from these national level facilities for sports like football, archery and hockey are available in Ranchi.



## How to reach

### Airways

Birsa Munda Airport (IXR) of Ranchi has direct flights from Patna, Kolkata, Delhi, Mumbai and Bangalore through major airlines like Air India, Go Air, Indigo and Air Asia. Plans are underway to connect Ranchi directly with cities like Chennai and Hyderabad. A new domestic terminal is now ready which is spread over 19,676 square metres of land and has the capacity to handle 500 domestic passengers.

### Railways

Ranchi Railway Station is well connected to Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai, Chennai and other major cities with direct trains running on a daily basis. It consists of six platforms with all standard necessities catering to 36 halting trains, 27 originating trains and 27 terminating trains. It is also well connected to Ranchi Airport and Bus Terminals.

## Tourist Attractions

1. **Gonda Hill and Rock Garden** is situated at a distance of about 4 km from Ranchi town on Ranchi Kanke Road. Rock Garden is carved out of the rocks of Gonda Hill and resembles its design to rock garden of Jaipur. At the base of the Hill is Kanke Dam.
2. **Hundru Falls:** It is 45 km from Ranchi on Ranchi-Purulia Road. Here, the Subarnarekha river falls from a height of 320 ft (98 m).
3. **Jonha Falls:** Jonha Falls also known as Gautamdihara, is around 40 km from Ranchi. It is approachable by both Road and train. The fall can be admired by descending around 500 steps. The river Kanchi flows nearby.
4. **Panchghagh Falls:** Panchghagh falls is on Ranchi-Chakradharpur Road about 6 km from Khunti. This fall consists of five streams formed in a row due to the breaking up of the Banai river which falls from a good height.
5. **Dassam Falls:** Dassam falls is 34 km from Ranchi on Ranchi-Tata Road near a village called Taimara. Here, the Kachni river falls from an altitude of 144 ft (44 m). It is also known as Dassam Gagh.
6. **Hirni Falls:** Another waterfall amidst forests about 70 km from Ranchi.
7. **Nakshatra Van:** Nakshatra Van is situated in the heart of the city. It is divided into various sections. There is a big circle in the centre of the park which is divided into arcs.
8. **Crocodile Breeding Centre, Muta, Ormajhi:** About 60 km from the Ranchi, on NH-20 near Sikidri lines is breeding place for the Crocodiles. It has been recognized as Mini Zoo by the Zoo Authority of India
9. **Jagannathpur Temple:** It is 10 km away from Ranchi town. Jagannathpur temple was built in 1691 having resemblance with architectural style of Puri temple. Thakur Ani Nath Shahdeo, of Barkagarh Jagannathpur built the temple.

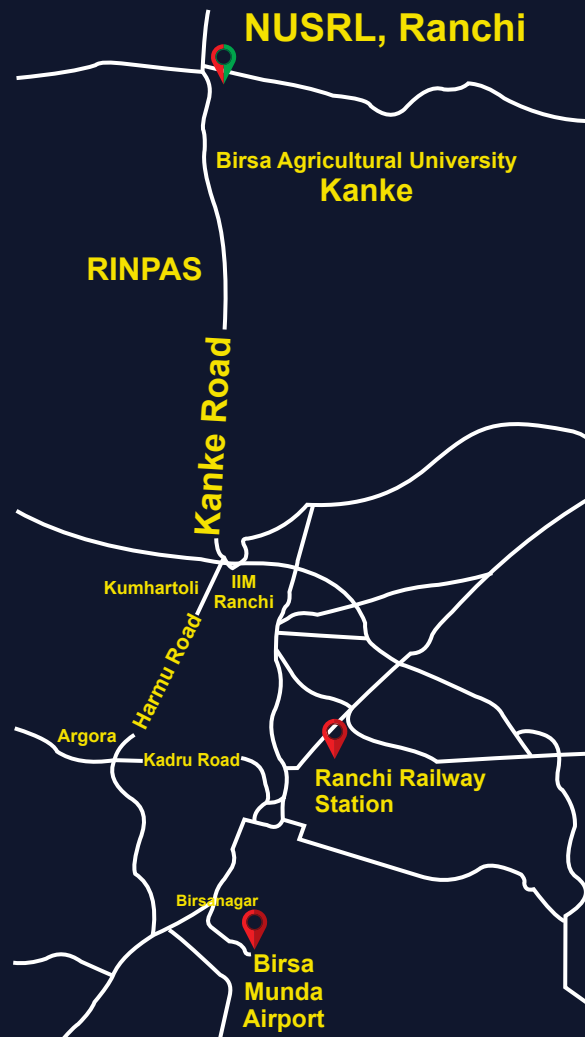
